STATIONS OF THE CROSS LITURGY

We will be holding our Easter Celebrations this Thursday at 11:45am. We will begin with the Stations of the Cross; each grade has prepared 2 stations to present to the school. Students are to wear the uniform that they normally wear on a Thursday. Parents are welcome to attend.

FROM THE REC

Station 11 – Jesus is nailed to the cross.

Jesus is nailed to the cross. Through His hands. Through His feet. The pain is unbelievable. Jesus knows this is the last pain for Him. He does not get angry and does not react to the pain. He looks at the soldiers who hurt him and He asks for God to forgive them. He looks at His mother, Mary. He asks the disciples to look after her. Jesus is still thinking of others.

How do you feel as you stand at this station. Do you feel the pain, the sadness? Would you be so selfless? Could you think of others?

We are often wounded by painful words, do we think of those people and ask for them to be forgiven? Do we find it easy to forgive? Stand at the cross and ask Jesus to help you to forgive people who hurt you.

Station 12 - Jesus dies on the cross.

Jesus has been condemned. Walked. Fallen. Walked. Stumbled. Been helped. Beaten. Stripped. Nailed to the cross. Now Jesus bows His head. **It is done!** He dies.

How do you feel as you stand at this station?

Jesus did this for us. For you. For me. For us. How do you feel as you realise this? Is there anything you can do for others? Ask Jesus to show you how you can make a difference; He will show you the way in your life.

This is the day we call Good Friday.

This is the day Jesus gave us as a gift.

This is the day of all days, the day which we thank God for every time He forgives us.

And yet this is not the end. This is just the beginning.


