
Bede Polding Year 7 Enrolments 2019



MATHEMATICS

You can help your child's learning every day, by supporting and encouraging them and being excited by their learning. Here are some ideas to support them to develop their Mathematics skills at home.

YEAR 1

Talk together have fun with Numbers and Patterns

- find numbers around your home and neighbourhood clocks, letterboxes, speed signs
- count forwards and backwards (clocks, fingers and toes, letterboxes, action rhymes, signs)
- make patterns when counting "clap 1, stamp 2, clap 3, stamp 4, clap 5..."
- do sums using objects such as stones or marbles eg 2 + 3, 4 + 1, 5 + 4
- make up number stories "you have 2 brothers and 2 sisters. How many children altogether?"

Maths is an important part of everyday life and there are lots of ways you can make it fun and enjoy maths with your children.

YEAR 2

Talk together have fun with Numbers and Patterns

- find and connect numbers around your home and neighbourhood; eg find 7, 17 and 27 on letterboxes
- count forwards and backwards starting with different numbers (eg 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, then back again)
- make patterns when counting forwards and backwards (eg "5, 10, 15, 20 then 20, 15, 10, 5 and 30, 40, 50, 60 or 12, 14, 16, 18, ...")
- do addition and subtraction problems by counting forwards or backwards in their heads (eg 8 + 4, 16 3)

Being positive about Mathematics is really important for your child's learning – even if you didn't enjoy it or do well at it yourself at school.

Does your child catch a school bus? Help them keep it!

As the bus operator providing your child's school bus services, we're asking for your help getting your child to use their Opal card on every bus trip.

Since the introduction of the School Opal card in 2016, school bus patronage data has significantly dropped. This is not reflected in the number of students actually travelling on our buses for various reasons a large number of students are consistently not using their Opal cards as they should be.

Opal data gathered by tapping on and off is used by transport planners and service schedulers to design the bus network that best serves the community utilising the resources available.

If students don't tap on and off then school bus services will appear underutilised and may be considered for cancellation based on low passenger numbers.

Please help us reinforce the message that tapping on and off every bus journey with an Opal card is essential to travel on the bus. This will ensure school services continue to be planned for the students that use it, providing the journey to school your children depend on.

FAMILY PHOTOS - Should you wish to have a family photograph taken, please fill out the family section at the bottom of your child's Order form . These photos are for school aged students attending the school and no family photo will be taken unless an order form has been received on photo day.

SPLIT FAMILIES - you can use the same shoot key provided on the order form to order for your child. Any students with multiple orders processed will have their photographs sent in separate satchels to the school. There is a section on the order form for you to tick "Split Family" so we can place a "Mums Order" or "Dads Order" sticker on the satchel. If you think there may be a problem in receiving the photographs or you don't have an order form/shoot key, please phone MSP Photography on 02 9831 5505 so we can assist you.
