## **ATTENDANCE**

Parents are reminded of their responsibilities in ensuring that children attend school regularly. The Education Act (1990) outlines these responsibilities in explicit detail. When children are absent from school for any length of time, including late arrival and early departure, a written explanation is required. Without an explanation, the school is required to record the absence as 'unexplained'. Schools and school systems are required to report on student absences each year to the Department of Education and Training. Absences are also reported in our annual audit. I thank you for your continued understanding and support in this important matter.

## COMPLAINTS & GRIEVANCES

Should parents have any questions or concerns about their child's learning or well-being, the first point of reference should always be the child's teacher. Parents are most welcome to then contact the member of the Leadership Team who has responsibility for the grade that the child is enrolled (Mrs McKay for K, 1 and 2; Mrs Van Der Burg for Years 3 and 4; Miss Gray for Years 5 and 6). Parents are then most welcome to contact the Assistant Principal or Principal for an interview. The school has formal written protocols in place to address complaints and grievances. These protocols are in line with the Catholic Education, Diocese of Parramatta (CEDP), Complaint Handling Policy. At this time of the year parents often request copies of reports for Year 7 applications. Please understand that given how busy our school office is, it is unrealistic to expect our secretaries to provide an 'on the spot' service. Our aim is to provide such requests within a 48 hour time frame. A charge of \$10.00 applies to all requests for extra reports and needs to be paid on collection. 
