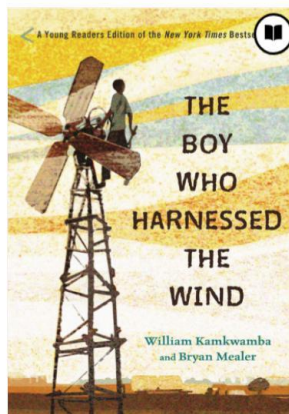

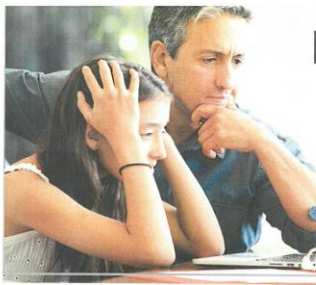
Young Readers Edition
