

RAAF Base Richmond
PFAS Investigation and Management Program

The Department of Defence is holding a Community Walk-in Session as part of the investigation and management of per- and poly- fluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) on, and in the vicinity of RAAF Base Richmond.

The session is being held to provide an update to the community on the development of the PFAS Management Area Plan.

Members of the Project Team will be available to discuss and answer questions about the outcomes of the completed environmental investigation as well as provide information on the remediation and management activities being considered as part of the PFAS Management Area Plan.
