## Dear Families,

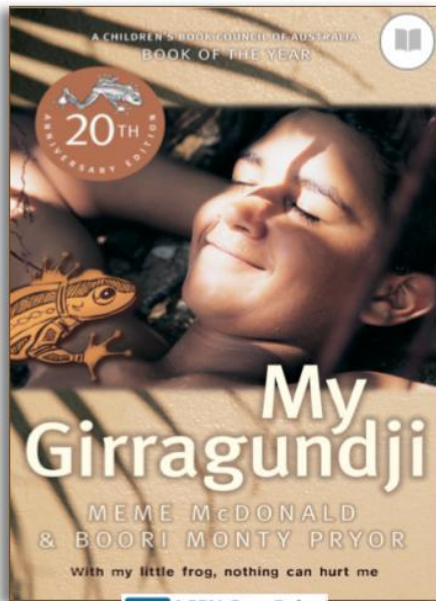

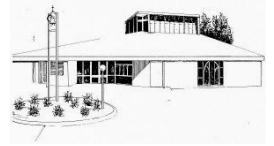
