At yesterday's assembly I launched 'Feed a Farmer's Family' in support of our farmers, whose livelihood is being severely impacted by the drought. Farmers are not only struggling to feed their stock, many are also struggling to feed their families. Each Friday for the remainder of Term 3 we will run 'Fifty cent Friday' where children are encouraged to bring in any spare 50c pieces that they have to contribute to this social justice cause. Money collected will be forward to the Country Women's Association (NSW) who, through their Drought Aid Grants, is providing up to \$3000.00 assistance to eligible families to help meet household expenses. These can include grocery bills, vehicle maintenance, school expenses, electricity, council rates, telephone, dental and medical treatment. I have been assured that all money raised through the CWA goes to the farmers and money is not deducted to cover their administrative costs. I know that we have asked a lot of families recently with the walka-thon and the lead up to the fete, however everyone would agree that this is a very worthy cause and any donation, no matter how small, will assist!


