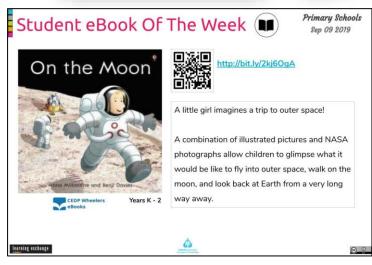
A notification of successful completion of the module will be sent via email to the school and also to your email address. This online training must be completed *every 2 years*.
