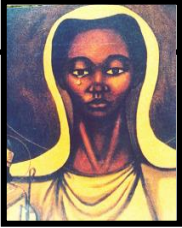

## SCHOOL FEES

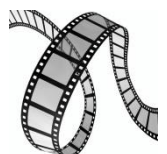

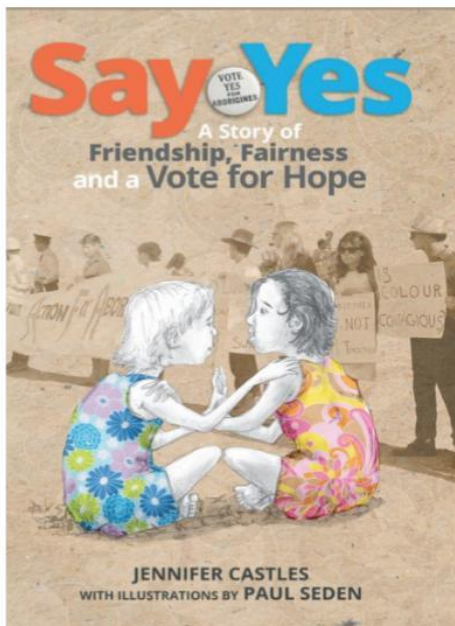
